ORDER

As per the Government Order read above, the scales of pay of Government employees and teachers were revised with effect from 1.7.2004. Rule 19 of Annexure 2 to the above Government Order permits an employee on leave to exercise option within a period of six months from the date of return to duty. As per Rule 12 therein the option is restricted to the date of his next promotion or one year from the date of order of 2004 Pay Revision whichever is earlier.

(2) Now it has come to the notice of Government that employees who rejoined duty after availing LWA during the period from 1.7.2004 to 24.3.2007 and whose increment fall due after 24.3.2007 are deprived of the benefit of exercising option on the increment date due to the provision contained in Rule 12.

(3) Government have examined the issue in detail and are pleased to order that the employees who continue on Leave Without Allowance (LWA) on or after 1.7.2004 will be allowed to exercise option within 6 (six) months of return to duty subject to the condition that the date of effect of such option shall not extend beyond the date of the next increment that accrues after 24.3.2007 or the date of 1st promotion/grade whichever is earlier. However, employees will not be permitted to opt the promotion post for Pay Revision in such cases.


