PAY REVISION 2004—BENEFIT OF OPTION FACILITY FOR FIXATION OF PAY UNDER RULE 28A PART I KERALA SERVICE RULES TO THE EMPLOYEES WHO ARE APPOINTED TO HIGHER POSTS BY PUBLIC SERVICE COMMISSION ETC.—GRANTED—ORDERS ISSUED

ORDER

As per provision contained in para 49 of Government Order read as 1st paper above and in the Government Order read as 2nd paper above, option facility is admissible in all cases of regular promotions including ratio based promotions when pay is fixed under Rule 28A Part I Kerala Service Rules. But in para 52 of the Government Order first read above, option facility is not granted in cases of upgradation of post or in appointments to higher posts on the advice of Public Service Commission (PSC) or otherwise (in respect of persons already in State Government Service).

2. Government have examined the matter in detail and are pleased to extend the benefit of option facility as contained in para 49 of Government Order 1st read above as modified in the Government Order read 2nd above to the employees in cases of upgradation of posts (involving higher duties and responsibilities) or in appointments to higher posts on the advice of PSC or otherwise (in respect of persons already in State Government Service) when pay is fixed under Rule 28A Part I Kerala Service Rules.

3. The option shall be exercised within one month from the date of appointment order or date of taking over charge of the new post whichever is later. In the case of appointments that have taken place after 25-3-2006, the employees will be allowed to exercise option within 3 (three) months from the date of this order.
