*Sub:—Pre-check bills in respect of Retired Gazetted Officer—Clarification—
Regarding.*

*Ref:—Letter from Accountant General (A&E), Kerala, Thiruvananthapuram
No. GE 02/B/8944 dated 11-8-2011.*

The Accountant General (A&E), Kerala, in the letter cited has brought to the notice of Government the case of a retired Gazetted Officer who submitted 17 months salary bill for pre-check invoking provision in exception (3) to rule 182, KTC Vol. I. It is observed that some Gazetted Officers deliberately postpone submission of salary bill to treasury till retirement to evade Co-operative recoveries that could have otherwise been made from the salary.

The Accountant General has therefore requested to issue necessary guidelines taking into account that the provision to pre-check the claims of retired Gazetted Officer should not be circumvented to claim pay and allowances, that could be drawn while in service and deliberately undrawn to evade the recoveries outstanding.

Article 89 (3) (d) of KFC Vol. I stipulates that in cases where the Government Servant concerned intentionally allows his pay to remain undisbursed or undrawn with a view to evade payment on account of due to Co-operative Societies, the administrative head of department concerned should draw the pay of the debtor-employee under intimation to the employee in satisfaction of the requisition received from the Co-operative Society and remit the amount to the society without undue delay.

In the circumstances all treasury officers are directed to bring the matter of such undrawn pay of Gazetted Officers for longer duration, to the notice of Heads of Departments/Officers and Heads of Departments shall take action as stipulated in Article 89 (3) (d) of KFC Vol. I. Any lapse in this regard will be viewed seriously.
