ORDER

1. As per Government Order read first above, the power of Chief Engineer to issue technical sanction was limited to ₹ 2 crore. For according Technical Sanction above ₹ 2 crore upto ₹ 5 crore, a team of Chief Engineers is the competent authority and for according Technical Sanction above ₹ 5 crore, the Committee consisting of Chief Engineer, Secretary [Irrigation] and Secretary [Finance] is the authority.

2. In the meeting of Chief Secretary held on 26-10-2004 to discuss the issues relating to Administrative Sanction and allied matter of PWD, it was decided inter alia that Chief Engineer is the competent authority to issue technical sanction.

3. Government have examined the matter in detail and are pleased to order as follows:

[i]. The powers of Chief Engineer to issue Technical Sanction is enhanced from ₹ 2 crore to ₹ 5 crore and for according Technical Sanction above ₹ 5

crore upto ₹ 10 crore Chief Engineer's Committee shall be the competent authority.

[ii]. Technical Sanction exceeding ₹ 10 crores will be cleared by the Committee consisting of Secretary [PWD] as Chairman and Chief Technical Examiner and Chief Engineer [Design] as members.
