S. R. O. No. 26/2013.—In exercise of the powers conferred by sub-section (1) of section 2 of the Kerala Public Services Act, 1968 (19 of 1968), read with section 3 thereof, the Government of Kerala hereby make the following rules further to amend the Kerala Service Rules, namely:—

RULES

1. *Short title and commencement.*—(1) These Rules may be called the Kerala Service (Second Amendment) Rules, 2013.

(2) They shall come into force at once.

2. *Amendment of the Rules.*—In Part I of the Kerala Service Rules,—

(a) in rule 76, after the existing proviso, the following proviso shall be inserted, namely:—

“Provided further that no commutation of leave shall be permitted on expiry of one year from the date of sanction of leave.”;

(b) in rule 89, in sub-rule (i), after the existing proviso, the following proviso shall be inserted, namely:—

“Provided further that no commutation of leave shall be permitted on expiry of one year from the date of sanction of leave.”.

Explanatory Note

(This does not form part of the notification, but is intended to indicate its general purport.)

The existing provisions in rule 76 and rule 89 of Part I of the Kerala Service Rules enables conversion of one type of leave to a leave of different kind subject to the conditions therein. A growing tendency is noticed among the employees to convert the leave which was sanctioned even at the commencement of service, to another kind of leave, after a lapse a of long years which causes administrative inconvenience and unexpected financial burden. In order to avoid misuse of the said provision, the Government have decided to modify the rules suitably.

The notification is intended to achieve the above object.
