ORDER

The Principal Accountant General (A&E), Thiruvananthapuram vide letter 1st read above sought co-operation, advice and financial assistance from the part of State Government in their own ICT project for digitization of entitlement records of State Government employees starting with pension records of retired State Government employees and teachers maintained in her office. In the letter, it has been submitted that the total expenditure for the work will be of the order of ₹86,51,000 (Rupees eighty six lakh fifty one thousand only).

2. As per Government Orders read 3rd and 4th paper above, sanction was accorded for disbursement of ₹1 Crore to the Director of Treasuries for making payment as per the advice of Accountant General (A&E) to meet the expenditure incurred in the office of Accountant General towards revision of pension ordered

vide Government Order read 2nd above. The Director of Treasuries as per letter read 5th paper above informed that an amount of ₹83,10,587 (Rupees eighty three lakh ten thousand five hundred and eighty seven only) has been paid to Accountant General for the above work. Accountant General quoted an amount after deducting the balance amount available with Director of Treasuries out of the one crore sanctioned for revision of pension as net requirement for carrying out digitization of pension records vide letter read 1st above.

3. After examining the proposal in detail, Government are pleased to accord Administrative Sanction for the digitization of pension records of retired State Government employees and teachers maintained in the office of Accountant General with an estimate cost amounting to ₹86,51,000 (Rupees eighty six lakh fifty one thousand only). The expenditure in this regard will be met from the head of account '2075-00-800-99 Setting up of Database for Government Employees and Pensioners-13th FCA NP-V'. The amount earmarked under the above head of account for the said work will be drawn by the Director of Treasuries, Thiruvananthapuram and kept in a separate TSB account to be opened by the Director of Treasuries in his name for this purpose. Payments from this head of account will be made by the Director of Treasuries as per certifications by the Accountant General (A&E), Kerala regarding execution and completion of the proposed work subject to the condition that the digitized data should be shareable with the State Government. Director of Treasuries will remit the balance amounting to ₹16,89,413 (Rupees sixteen lakh eighty nine thousand four hundred

and thirteen only) available with him as per letter last read above to the head of account '2054-00-911-99 Recoveries of Overpayments' since the work for which the amount was sanctioned is over.
