ORDER

1. As per G.O. read above instructions were issued for the speedy disposal of unserviceable articles and seized/ confiscated vehicles. Vide para 2 (b) of the above G.O. officers of Transport, Excise and Forest Department were empowered to fix the fair value of such vehicles in their respective Departments.

2. In the Empowered Committee meeting held on 28.06.2013 chaired by Chief Secretary constituted as per G.O. read above, Excise Department represented that the present system of Mechanical Engineer in Excise Department (on deputation from PWD) fixing fair value of seized vehicles as per Abkari Act may be allowed to continue with the approval of Deputy / Joint Excise Commissioner.

3. After having examined the matter in detail, Government are pleased to order that the fair value of seized vehicles may be fixed by the Mechanical Engineer in Excise Department, but the power to auction will be with the Deputy Excise Commissioner & Joint Excise Commissioner.

4. Para 2 (b) of the above G.O. pertaining to Excise Department is modified to the above extent.
