ORDER

1. Government have reintroduced House Building Advance scheme to State Government Employees and Teachers as per Government Order read as 1st paper above .

2. As per Government Order read as 4th paper above, Government have extended House Building Advance scheme to the teaching/non teaching staff working in 104 Panchayat/Municipality schools which have been taken over by Government as per Government Order 2nd and 3rd cited, subject to the conditions stipulated in the Government Order read as 1st above, from the financial year 2015-16.

3. Personnel & Administrative Reforms Department, as per reference 5th cited, has remarked that in the Government Order read as 3rd paper above, staff working in the above said schools are categorised into two, namely, staff recruited through Kerala Public Service Commission and staff appointed directly by Local Self Government Institutions. The staff recruited through Kerala Public Service Commission is included in the Government Service and the staff appointed directly by Local Self Government Institutions is included in a common pool. The staff included in the common pool can enter into Government Service through option by fixing their seniority from 02.01.2010. The criteria for seniority, promotion, grade, transfer etc. of staff in common pool are also fixed separately. Therefore, the staff included in the common pool cannot be considered as Government Servants.

4. In the circumstances, Government have examined the matter in detail and are pleased to limit House Building Advance Scheme to the following staff of 104 Panchayat/Municipality schools which have been taken over by Government, from the year 2015-16.

- i. Teaching/ non teaching staff recruited through Kerala Public Service Commission.
- ii. Teaching/ non teaching staff entered into Government service from the common pool through option as per the Government Order read as 3rd paper above.


