20% posts of Overseer Grade I/Draftsman Grade I in Factories & Boilers Department have been placed in the Higher Grade with the scale of pay of Rs. 9190-15510 as per footnote 'd' at page No. 122 of the G.O. read as 1st paper above. The Director of Factories & Boilers Department in the letter read as second paper above has reported that the above 20% ratio based higher grade cannot be implemented in the Factories and Boilers Department since the number of Draftsman in the Department is below 5.

Government have examined the matter in detail and are pleased to order that the footnote 'd' occurring in page No. 122, relating to item No. 21 Factories & Boilers Department, of the GO read as 1st paper above stands deleted. They will be eligible for Time Bound Higher Grade as per existing Rules.
